

## What is Speech Therapy?

Speech Therapy services are delivered by Licensed Speech-Language Pathologists (SLP) and Licensed Speech-Language Pathologist Assistants (SLP-A) in home settings.

- **Disfluency Disorder**

Stuttering or resonance issues affecting speech fluency.

- **Receptive/Expressive Language Disorders**

Difficulties with articulating thoughts, ideas, and feelings. Problems with syntax, language content, and socially appropriate communication.

- **Social Communication Disorders**

Challenges using verbal and nonverbal communication in social contexts.

- **Cognitive-Communication Disorders**

Problems organizing thoughts, maintaining attention, remembering information, planning, and problem-solving.

- **Swallowing Disorders (Dysphagia)**

Feeding and swallowing difficulties resulting from illness, surgery, stroke, injury, or congenital conditions.
